



EDUCATIONAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF NAPLES FEDERICO II

AND

THE UNIVERSITY OF DUBNA

FOR STUDENTS EXCHANGE (MASTER COURSE IN PHYSICS)

Seeing there is already a collaboration agreement between the University of Naples Federico II and the Dubna State University signed on 2005, this document is meant for a renewal of the previous agreement.

With the aim of allowing your own students the widening of their own curriculum through important experiences abroad, the parties agree on the following:

ARTICLE 1 - Definitions

If it has not already been indicated:

HOME INSTITUTION refers to the University that will confer the final degree.

HOST INSTITUTION refers to the University that has accepted to admit the student for a study period, and which foresees the full recognition of credits for the courses attended and whose exams have been passed.

ARTICLE 2 - General Principles

The student exchange must be based on reciprocal bases with the aim of reaching an equal number exchanges by both parties for an agreed upon period of time.

There is no obligation on the part of both institutions to activate the student exchange or to accept students for the present programme.

ARTICLE 3 - Modalities for exchange students

The parties agree to exchange a maximum number of 5 students for the academic year. The length of the exchange will be agreed upon every time according to the demands of the parties.

The home institution will be responsible for the search and the selection of the students.

The students will be required to have a good knowledge of English to be admitted to the final selection.

The students who will take part in the exchange must keep to the rules and norms asked for by the host institution.

The host institution will ensure that the students have the necessary logistic support.

The students who take part in the exchange will have to personally take care of obtaining a visa and complete all bureaucratic requirements necessary to expatriate.

ARTICLE 4 - Enrolment, attendance and student evaluation

The students who take part in the exchange will be able to enrol on any course set up by the Master course in Physics for which they have the necessary requirements, following the regulations for admission, the timetables and the limits imposed by the host institution.

The students will have the credits for the attended courses recognized according to the rules of the home institution.

The host institution will give them official certificates with a transcription of the credits obtained.



ARTICLE 5 - Fees and subsidiary expenses

The students who take part in the exchange will be enrolled in both institutions but will pay their fee to the home institution, which will support the travel. The living expenses (accommodation and meals) will be supported by the host institution.

ARTICLE 6 - Health Insurance

All students taking part in the exchange must stipulate a suitable insurance policy for the total length of the exchange.

ARTICLE 7 - Person Responsible

For the University of Naples Federico II, the co-ordinator responsible for the educational agreement is: Prof. Gennaro Miele Structure: Department of Physics "E. Pancini"
For the Dubna State University the co-ordinator responsible for the agreement is: Voinova A.A., the Head of International Academic Mobility Center.

ARTICLE 8 - Modifications and Length

The present Educational Agreement can be modified by mutual consent, in writing, and must be signed by both parties. If stipulated as an added piece of protocol it has the same length as the agreement set out in the premise.
